On 02/01/2024, HA was informed by the chiller manufacturer's representative that the proposed 513a refrigerant chillers will have a higher-pressure loss through the condenser section of the chiller than originally anticipated this has a potential for the existing condenser water pump to be undersized.
 - b. HA to investigate and issue amendment documents if new condenser pumps are required.
- 4. Addendums may possibly change the bid due date.
- 5. Lead times are anticipated to be approximately 6 to 7 months for certain equipment, concerns voiced about 180-day project duration.
