PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 EXISTING FACILITIES TO BE REMOVED

- A Saw cut concrete pavement, asphalt concrete pavement along straight lines, make each cut in vertical faces perpendicular to the face and in alignment with the cut in the opposite face. Saw cut edges of the intended demolition area as marked to avoid feather-edging.
- B Use a handheld pneumatic chipping hammer or jack hammers. Use of vehicle-mounted breakers is prohibited. The District will not consider change order requests for "hard concrete".
- C Remove dust, dirt, and loosely bonded material resulting from cleaning.
- D Patching. Trenches, holes, depressions, pits and damaged surfaces caused by demolition and removal shall be filled and patched with non-shrink materials of similar composition, equal to or better in quality and to match the same dimensions of the surrounding materials. Where work, as specified in these Technical Specifications is to be applied to existing surfaces, perform removals and patching in a manner to produce surfaces suitable for receiving such work. Finished surfaces of patched area shall be flush with the adjacent existing surface and shall match the existing adjacent surface as closely as possible as to texture, finish, and color unless indicated otherwise in the Drawings.

3.2 DISPOSAL OF MATERIAL

- A Title to Materials. Except where specified herein or in other sections, all materials and equipment demolished or removed, and not reused, shall become the property of the Contractor and shall be removed from District Tidelands. Title to materials resulting from demolition is vested to the Contractor upon approval by the Port District. The District will not be responsible for the condition, loss of, or damage to such property after notice to proceed. Materials and equipment shall not be viewed by prospective purchasers or sold on the site.
- B Reuse of Materials and Equipment. Remove and store materials and equipment indicated to be reused or relocated in the Contractor's storage area, or as noted on the Drawings, to prevent damage and weathering, and reinstall as the work progresses.
- C Debris Disposal. Demolition and removal materials including debris shall be disposed of outside District Tidelands in compliance with all federal, state and local regulations.
