**MIDVALE CITY PUBLIC NOTICE:**

Bidders are invited to bid on Midvale Plaza and Streetscape. The location of the work is in Midvale City, Utah, at the Midvale City Hall, located at 7505 Holden Street. The scope of work entails the plaza to the south of the building, a small planter bed at the southwest corner of the parking lot, the median in Holden Street, the streetscape on Main Street, the proposed plaza to the north of the building, and the streetscape/landscaping improvements on the east side of Holden Street, north of City Hall. Midvale City owns the location of the work. For purposes of this Project and Contract, the owner is the Redevelopment Agency of Midvale City (RDA). The RDA has entered into an agreement with the City to perform the work under this Contract and has all necessary permissions to access and use the Site. The work to be performed consists of furnishing, providing, and installing the facilities, equipment, services, and appurtenances thereto as included in the Contract Documents. The Work generally includes, but is not limited to: Renovations to the existing southern plaza, renovations to the existing streetscape along Main Street east of City Hall, improvements and planting in the median on Holden Street, creating a new plaza on the north side of City Hall, installing a sidewalk from the new north plaza to the bridge abutments along Holden Street, and renovating the landscaping and irrigation along the east side of Holden Street.
